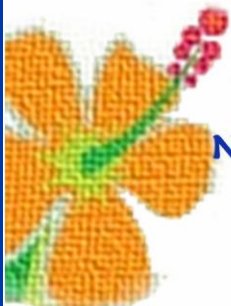

The Cornerstone Ducks have started their second season of varsity football 1-0 after defeating Life Christian Academy 6-0 in only one half of football. The Ducks started off with energy after junior Demonte Nelson's explosive 25 yard kickoff return to start the game. After outside runs of 5 and 15 yards from James Goodrich and Caleb Williams respectively, senior Sal Raitano took a trap up the middle for the only score of the game. The Ducks took a 6-0 lead and never looked back. Life Christian took the ball, but the Ducks' defense shut them out. Two deep pass break ups by senior SS Caleb Williams and a clutch interception around midfield by FS Patrick Fluellen shut down Life Christian's hopes on offense. Hakeem Dickson, Joel Matos, and Fluellen made big tackles against the run, keeping the Lions from scoring. The Ducks hustled off the field with a 6-0 lead at the half, but could not return to the field because the stadium lights failed to turn on making the conditions unsafe for further play.
