Parent Information

It is the mission of this program to offer character building, self-esteem, skill enhancing instruction, and nurturing to the k-5 students of Cornerstone Charter Academy. As a sports league we always strive to increase skill development, game strategy, game rules and enjoyment of sports. It is our hope that sports can be “Fun and Competitive” with an emphasis on doing one’s best while respecting the coaches, officials and opponents. We must provide a safe, fun environment for our students to exercise and develop physical skills that will lead to a healthy and fulfilling lifestyle. We must encourage them positively with love and always remember that the *most important thing to them* is to have FUN.

League Positive Affirmation Rules: This program is built on people volunteering their time. Coaches, assistant coaches, team moms, referees and other volunteers are what make this league possible. These people work hard to insure that all of the children who participate will experience teamwork, friendship, family and understanding. Please review our “co-ed rules” and instruct visitors you bring.

1. Never speak negatively toward your child or any other player.
2. Never speak negatively toward an adult (coach, volunteer or another parent).
3. Never criticize a call made by an official.
4. All complaints should be reported to and will be addressed by Coach or Athletic Director.
5. Please do not react poorly if your child does not win a game.

These rules are in place to insure that our focus is on “what is best for our students.” These children want to have fun and play the game.

Registration Fee: \$50.00 (registration/sign up October 22nd)

Equipment: All players must wear their soccer t-shirt on game day. Each player will need to wear cleats or sneakers and shin guards for their practices and games. **Sizing for game T-shirts will take place at time of sign up and/or start up meeting. You must select the correct size you want. Parents who have to reorder for incorrect sizes will be charged for both uniforms.** **Jewelry:** No player is allowed to wear jewelry to practice or games. No rings, bracelets, necklaces or ear rings.

Forming Teams: Assignment of teams will be based upon skill levels and age to keep the playing field as level as possible. **Coaches:** All coaches must be Additions approved and will earn school volunteer hours for their services. *Please go to(www.volunteer.ocps.net) and submit/update your ADDitions application!

Practices: Practices will be held on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 3:00-4:30. The dates for practices will be provided after sign-up and teams have been assigned.

Games: All games will be held on Saturdays and played at the Cornerstone Charter Academy field. Game schedules will be emailed out weekly to your coaches. Each team will play a total of at least 6 games. The game dates will be provided once the program is in place.

Team Pictures: Pictures will be taken prior to the first game.

During games: Players are expected to remain with their team at all times if they are not on the field while the game is being played. It's distracting and difficult to keep up with them if they are running to their parents at will. This will allow coaches to make sure everyone is accounted for and gets their proper turn to play. Please encourage your child to follow this rule. Parents are not allowed on the field at anytime during the games.

Parents: You are the key to your child's development and enjoyment. Work with them at home if you can. Be encouraging!! You are their best cheerleader!!! We take this responsibility very seriously and will do all that we can to meet the goals I detailed at the beginning of this letter.
